

Fantasy Island Program: A Transformative Journey of Imagination and Learning

Program Structure

Each one-hour session is thoughtfully structured to maximize engagement and learning. Groups of 20 participants, divided into four islands with five members each, embark on weekly quests via Google Meet, with collaboration on Google Slides, Docs, and Photos.

1. **Welcome & Introduction:** The session begins with a warm welcome and introduction to the day's quest.
2. **Presentation of Subtopics:** A presentation of subtopics, complete with inspirational images, is followed by brainstorming and a Q&A session.
3. **Production Phase:** Participants move into breakout rooms to collaborate on implementing the subtopics into their islands. The group documents their ideas while the Ambassador provides guidance, rotating between rooms.
4. **Presentation:** Each island presents their progress, sharing their newly developed concepts.
5. **Q&A Session:** A guided Q&A session encourages further exploration and reflection.
6. **Interactive Game:** The session concludes with a fun, interactive game, reinforcing the day's learning in an enjoyable way.

All content is age-appropriate, ensuring a safe and enriching experience for every child.

Monthly Breakdown

Month 1:

- **Three 1-Hour Quests:** Participants review the inspiring images and facts they've been presented. Followed by quests and tasks based on the subtopics to create new areas of their islands. Collaborative teamwork is emphasized as members implement ideas, present their progress, and engage in a game.
- **One 1-Hour Game Quest:** The Ludus Cup—a spirited tournament that fosters friendly competition across islands and regions.

Month 2:

- **Two 1-Hour Quests:** Focused on further crafting and expanding the islands.
- **One 1-Hour Leviathan Quest:** Participants create mythical Leviathans, adding a layer of legend to their islands.
- **One 1-Hour Game Quest:** Another round of the Ludus Cup, encouraging camaraderie and competition.

Month 3:

- **Two 1-Hour Quests:** Continued island development, enhancing the unique characteristics of each creation.
- **One 1-Hour Hózhó Quest:** A special challenge where all of PelagoNation collaborates to bring Hózhó, the cultural capital island symbolizing harmony, to life.
- **One 1-Hour Game Quest:** The final Ludus Cup of the adventure.

Month 4:

- **Three 1-Hour Quests:** Creative tasks, image creation, and the thrill of discovery define these sessions, drawing from the previous three months' experiences.
- **One 1-Hour Presentation Quest:** A showcase event where participants present their island's development and artistic creations to parents and friends.

- **Artistic Support:** Throughout this month, members can submit ideas for images they wish to see on their islands, which are then brought to life by our Art Master through PelagoImagine.
